Dear Mr. Stecklow:

Metra's FOIA Department ("FOIA Department") is responding to your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On September 3, 2019, the FOIA Department received your request for "any reports, documents, photos, videos, audio, or any other type of documentation maintained by the Metra Police Department regarding the police-involved shooting at 519 E. Sibley Blvd. in Dolton." A document provided by the Cook County Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management indicates MPD responded to the scene ("**Request**").

After performing a search of Metra's records, we have been unable to locate any records responsive to your Request. Metra's Police Department ("MPD") informs that its officers were not dispatched to the scene of this incident. As Metra does not maintain records of outside agencies, you may submit your request for records to the Illinois State Police.
